## DIRECTIONS

**From the North:** I-95 S to exit 78 onto VA-161 S/N Arthur Ashe Blvd. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Robin Hood Rd. Turn right onto Hermitage Road. Turn left onto Sherwood Ave. Turn right onto Reserve Street (should see signs for VCU facility).

**From the South:** I-95 N to exit 76 toward Chamberlayne Ave. Turn right onto Chamberlayne Pkwy. Slight left onto Brook Road. Turn left onto Sherwood Ave. Turn left onto Reserve Street (should see signs for VCU facility).

**From the East:** I-64 W to exit 78 to merge onto VA-161 S/N Arthur Ashe Blvd. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Robin Hood Rd. Turn right onto Hermitage Road. Turn left onto Sherwood Ave. Turn right onto Reserve Street (should see signs for VCU facility).

**From the West:** I-64 E to exit 76A toward Chamberlayne Ave. Turn right onto Chamberlayne Pkwy. Slight left onto Brook Road. Turn left onto Sherwood Ave. Turn left onto Reserve Street (should see signs for VCU facility).

## PARKING

Free parking is available to the right side of our building. If you come down Sherwood Avenue, you can make a turn directly into our parking lot at the entrance shown.

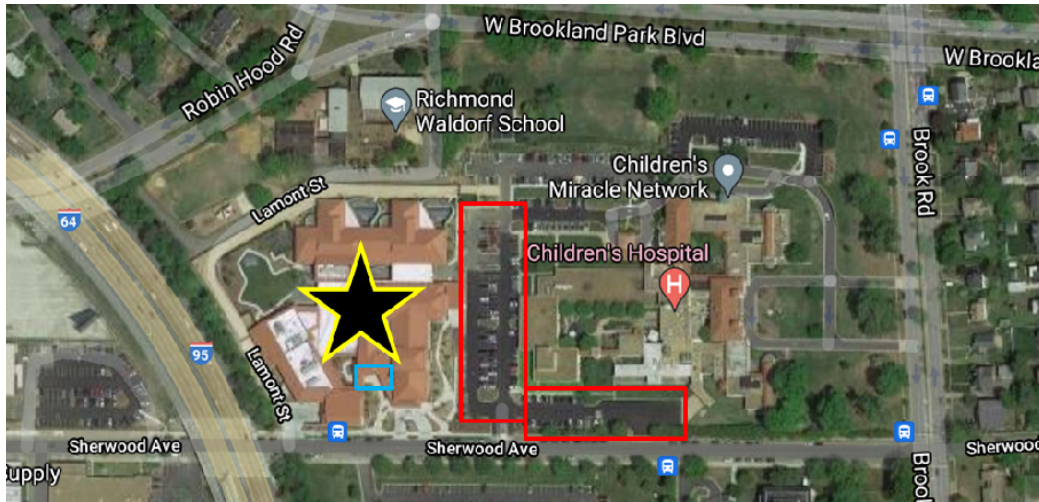
